
PRESENT SITUATION ON BIRD ATLAS WORKS IN SLOVAKIA

LAST BIRD ATLAS IN 2002

- In 2002 was published last bird atlas in Slovakia
- Another data were published in Czechoslovak studies before 2002, but none from them had complete data from Slovakia
- Atlas from 2002 was first real birdatlas mapping bird distribution in whole Slovakia filling gaps in knowledges from previous works/publications
- Bird distribution was registered in 429 sqaures with size 12x11 km (the same like in Czech Republic)
- This size of squares is used until now for different bird studies at national level
- Some data are not actual today, due to fast changes in bird distribution in Slovakia

PLANS FOR NEW BIRD ATLAS


- several bird species breeding according to data in 2002 are now missing in Slovakia
- several new species are breeding in Slovakia (Motacilla citreola, Tadorna tadorna, Mergus merganser)
- bird distribution for some species is different (*Lyrurus* tetrix decrease, *Strix uralensis* increase)
- also knowledges are much better than in 2002 and network of birdwatchers much wider
- Therefore steering committee of Slovak Ornithological Society agreed to initiate works on new bird atlas in 2012
- During membership meeting of SOS/BirdLife Slovakia at 23rd March that will be discussed
- Therefore outputs from Barcelona are important for SK

QUESTIONS TO SOLVE

- membership meeting of SOS/BirdLife Slovakia at 23rd March should solve several questions
- whether we will participate only in EBBA works, or we will use start EBBA also for starts of works on national atlas
- how to evaluate data
- shall we use our national size of mapping squares (12x11 km)
- o or shall we use UTM squares (10x10 km)
- problem is not evaluation of data, due to fact that majority of data today are gathered on exact local level, not only in summarizing data forms for particular square
- o problem is possible comparison with atlas in 2002
- Today is well working online system of gathering data


ONLINE BIRD DATABASE

- Today SOS, Slovak Academy of Sciences and RPS runs online database Aves (http://aves.vtaky.sk/)
- About 100000 data yearly
- Data written on exact locality basis
- It is possible to filter data according to species, according to category B1-D16 or combination
- It is possible to show filtered data in maps with marked squares where are placed these data (12x11 km and also 10x10 UTM) basis for atlas works
- Not everybody writes data on locality level, therefore we are preparing summarizing forms for squares
- Already now we have enaugh data for 50x50 km squares
- If some organization would like to use this online system it is for free





Buteo buteo – breeding in last two years Slovakia (online data only)





CONCLUSIONS

- today is completley different situation on bird distribution than in 2002 in Slovakia
- but also much more wider network of birdwatchers
- well established online databases (not only BirdLife) are working
- therefore we are very optimistic about future atlas works in Slovakia
- providing data for EBBA atlas should be no problem in GRID 50x50 km
- if there is possibility to help to other countries (by providing our online system, announcing where gaps of coverage are for interested birdwatchers) we can do it
