Bird species lists for 280 50x50km squares




1-5 timed surveys in each of 50x50km squares
















EBBA2 Ukraine. Pilot maps



Problem: Methodology VS Mentality Solution: Additional data needed













10x10 squares







Problem: Abundance estimation Solution: Checking the data, additional questionnaires if needed









Problem: Difference in Bird Latin Names



Problem: Gaps in rare species distribution Solution: Rare species groups











Problem: technical mistakes and unreliable data Solution: Checking the Data

BEFORE

- 282 breeding species
- Gaps in the distribution of rare species
- common bird species gaps / errors in abundance estimation

AFTER

- 276 breeding species
- Representative data on bird distribution
- More accurate abundance estimation
- Higher breeding category (as confirmed breeding)
 for many species







276 breeding bird species



3 new breeding species in 2017:

Greater Flamingo *Phoenicopterus roseus*

Cattle Egret Bubulcus ibis

Red Kite Milvus milvus







Why Atlas work was important for us?

- Quite accurate distribution maps of all breeding bird species – for the first time in country scale
- 2. Opportunity to achieve detailed data, to conduct field work, organize expeditions
- 3. Cooperation and collaboration the atlas project united ornithologists in Ukraine
- 4. Data will be used for National Bird Atlas
